Assignment Title: Consultancy services for Implementation of Resettlement Action Plan (RAP), Resettlement and Rehabilitation (R & R) Activities including Indigenous Peoples (Tribal) Development Plan (IPDP) and HIV / AIDS Prevention Plan (HPP) as part of Second Gujarat State Highway Project (GSHP-II)

The Government of India on behalf of Government of Gujarat (hereinafter called "Borrower") has applied for financing from the World Bank toward the cost of Gujarat State Highway Project - II. The Borrower intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

**The consultant will be broadly responsible for implementation of SIA, RAP, IPDP (TDP) and R&R activities including HIV/AIDS prevention plan (HPP) on the** Widening & Strengthening and Rehabilitation Road works of @ 625 km; will be implemented through various packages, under Second Gujarat State Highways Project (GSHP-II) which are to be supervised by "the consultancy firm Construction Supervision Consultant " and will be monitored by Project Management Consultancy (PMC) Services.

The works involve improvement of existing State Highways including geometric improvements and realignments, widening up to 2L, 2L+HS, 2L+PS+HS, 4L and strengthening and rehabilitation.

The above packages will be procured under National Competitive Bidding (NCB) as per procedures specified in the World Bank's guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits, (Revised January 2011).

## **SHORT LISTING CRITERIA**

### **A Annual Turn over**

1. Annual turnover of any one of the last five financial years i.e. from 2008 -2009 to 2012-2013 updated to the current financial year shall be more than Rs. 25 lac.
2. For arriving at updated value, turnover of any financial year shall be multiplied by the enhancement factor corresponding to that year.

### **B. Experience**

Consultancy firm must have as a prime Consultant successful experience as follows:

3. Implementation of work involving:
  - (a) RAP and R&R activities and
  - (b) Indigenous Peoples (Tribal) Development Plan (IPDP) and
  - (c) HIV / AIDS prevention plan

Such work must have been completed within last ten Calendar years including 2012.
