Short listing criteria

A Annual Turn over

- 1. Annual turnover from operational business of any one of the last five financial years i.e. from 2008 -2009 to 2012-2013 updated to the current financial year shall be more than Rs 250 lac.
- 2. For arriving at updated value, turnover of any financial year shall be multiplied by the enhancement factor corresponding to that year.
